Breaking Open the Word-

Something old yet something new... Breaking Open the Word is a time for young children to delve into the Sunday's Scripture and experience God's love at their level. Over twenty years ago at St. Casimir's, four year olds through 4th grade would be dismissed from Mass and follow adult and high school leaders to the church basement where they would hear God's word read from a Children's Lectionary. They would act out scripture, sign in ALS and sing; their own Liturgy of the Word. Now some of now grown children can send their own children to experience Mass in a new way. Beginning November 6, Children four years to fourth grade will follow adult leaders to the church basement before the Lector reads. They will be supervised as they learn about the meaning of God's Word for them.
