School Update...

The fourth grade SCS class has been learning about Fictional Narratives and Inferencing in Language Arts. They have learned that key points of a fictional narrative include character(s), a setting, a problem and a solution. Developing the skill of inferring includes taking observations from a text and our schema - personal experiences - which help us to read between the lines and infer what the author is trying to tell us. In third grade Language Arts, the students are learning how to summarize realistic, fictional text and reviewing what comprises nouns and verbs. They are getting experienced in finding/recognizing nouns and verbs in text as well as correctly using them in sentences of their own.

Fourth grade Math is all about addition properties and subtraction rules. Commutative, associative and identity are the three properties of addition, while the subtraction rules are as follows: 1.) when you subtract 0 from any number, the result is the number; 2.) when you subtract any number from itself the result is 0. Math class for the third graders also involves addition properties and subtraction rules as well as multi-step word problems.

Science is a joint study unit for the two grades in which they are wrapping up study on the systems of the human body. Currently, they are studying the skeletal system in which they have learned the names of the major bones, the purpose of the skeletal system and the types of joints that are in the human body, such as pivot joints.

Sacraments of Christian Initiation are the current topic in the third and fourth grade Religion class. The three Sacraments of Initiation are Baptism, Confirmation and the Eucharist. We are learning that sacraments are a celebration of God's love and grace.
