STC Policy on Mass Intentions: While the parishes wish to be supportive of the need for Mass intentions for loved ones, in fairness to all we have decided to set the limits as follows: (1) We can only schedule for 1 year in advance Starting December 1st. (2) Cost for the Mass is \$5.00 per intention. (Please come with the correct amount as we don't have change here in the office.) (3) Only 3 Masses per person will be accepted for the year. (4) If there is a large amount of money available, the church will ask if part of it can be a donation, or if part of it can be sent to the Seminary or the missions to be used for intentions there. We hope this clarifies the method of scheduling Mass intentions for the parishes.
