

#### From Fr. Havel...

God is good! Life is good! Time to move forward. As of Sunday, Feb. 13, there are 16 days before Ash Wednesday. It is time to begin planning for our Lenten journeys. We can begin by asking ourselves, how is God calling me to grow closer to Him in this holy season? Jesus tells us in the Gospels that prayer, fasting, and almsgiving are ways to grow closer to God the Father.

### Some thoughts:

- Prayer- Celebrate Mass on Ash Wednesday and all Sundays during Lent. Try to celebrate a weekday mass each week. Pray the rosary each day as you go for a walk (good for the soul and body).
- 2) Fasting- Fast (2 smaller meals and 1 regular meal each day with no snacks). Fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Abstinence (no meat) should be followed on Ash Wednesday and all Fridays during Lent. Fast (give up) some TV or computer time and share it with your family. (Maybe rediscover board games with your kids or neighbors).
- 3) Almsgiving- Try to be generous in your support of our parish or other charities. Be always mindful of the poor. Almsgiving isn't only about money. Look for ways to share your time with others through visits, cards, phone calls. Give generously of ourselves to others.

These are some other options:

- 1) Daily reflection books are available for you at each parish ( help yourself)
- 2) Rice bowls
- 3) Stations of the Cross books can be used at home.
- 4) Take advantage of the Sacrament of Reconciliation.
