School Update.....

Greetings from the SCS Students in Grades 3-6!

During Women's History Month in March, the students read about important women from our country and others. One important person was Yousafzai, the young woman from Pakistan who was shot by the Taliban for standing up for the right to an education for girls. She went on to win a Nobel Peace Prize for her bravery. Another woman was Elizabeth Blackwell, the first American female doctor.

The third and fourth grade students are continuing to learn about the regions of our country in their Social Studies lessons. They are just finishing the southeast region and learning about the Civil War. The students have also gained knowledge about the cities, natural resources and industries of this area. The fifth and sixth grade students are studying the life of people in the thirteen colonies, including the hardships of the early settlers along with the harsh reality of slavery. We will soon be moving on to the events that led up to the Revolutionary War and our country's independence.

On Fridays, the four grades gather to learn about economic studies, including the invention of the assembly line by Henry Ford. The students were placed in groups of four to create their own assembly lines by making candy cars. Two students put on the tires (round peppermint candies), another put on the seat (Jolly Ranchers) and the last person installed the steering wheel (life savers) which was held up with Dot candies. I think they will remember this tasty lesson about the process of assembly lines!
