Schimek Farewell Celebration



(If the Mass needs to be cancelled for a funeral the intention will be rescheduled).

I am also beginning to get the names of our parish members who are homebound. I will be beginning to get to their homes to visit, anoint, and bring Communion. I would like to change some of the times for the Sacrament of Reconciliation. This is done to allow me a little more time to prepare for the celebration of the Mass. Thank you for your understanding:

1. Saturday at St. John the Baptist:

Was 4:15-4:45 p.m. will now be 4:00-4:30 p.m.

2. Sunday at St. Casimir:

Was 7:15-7:45 a.m. will now be 7:00-7:30 a.m.

3. Our Lady of Mount Carmel at St. John the Baptist:

Was Sunday after 10:00 a.m. Mass will now be Saturdays 9:30-10:00 a.m. & when the church is completed the sacrament will be at the church in Easton. (This time also allows me to be present at the church to set-up for Sunday Mass).

Another reason for the change is that if someone comes for the Sacrament, for example, at 4:40 p.m. on Saturday evening, I don't want them or myself to feel rushed because Mass begins in a few minutes.
