We read in the Gospel this weekend that, “the person who is trustworthy in very small matters is also trustworthy in great ones and the person who is dishonest in very small matters is also dishonest in great ones.” This great insight calls us to do what is right all the time! We may want to say that it was only a small lie. It matters! If we are willing to tell small lies why would people trust us in bigger dealings.

I recognized a number of years ago how important our actions are even in small ways. I try to use my turn signals in the car even when I leave the parking lot or when no one is following me. It is a good habit that has grown over the years. A number of years ago I was within seconds of being involved in a serious car accident. As the accident happened next to me on a four-lane highway and being busy trying to avoid flying debris I recognized that throughout the whole time I had used my turn signals. All those times of using them when it seemed unnecessary trained me to use them in the seriousness of the accident.

Trust in God always. Be faithful to the Lord even when it may seem to be a small temptation. Small actions help build up the character of our lives and faithfulness in small matters will lead us to faithfulness in great events of our lives. ~Fr. Greg
