# October... The Month of the Most Holy Rosary

By tradition, the Catholic Church dedicates each month of the year to certain devotions. The month of October is dedicated to the Holy Rosary, one of the best known of all Catholic devotions, and the Feast of Our Lady of the Rosary is celebrated on October 7<sup>th</sup>. In what way will the students of SCS celebrate the Rosary? Throughout the month, the



students will be learning about the history of the Rosary and its importance in the Church during religion class. Did you know that when the Rosary is prayed, Mary is asked to pray for us as we seek to grow closer to her son Jesus by contemplating His life, death and Resurrection? Pretty remarkable!

- Fall Family Fun Fest: There will be an organizational meeting on October 3<sup>rd</sup> at 6:00 PM in our school gym, and you are invited to attend. We would love to have 100% parent/faculty involvement for what we hope will become the main annual fundraiser for Home and School. More information on this event can be found on the attached flyer.
- Second Sunday Social: As an outreach to our sponsoring parish, the Home and School Association has once again begun hosting a coffee and rolls event following the St. Casimir Masses on—you guessed it—every second Sunday of the month during the school year. This month's social will be held on October 8<sup>th</sup>, and it has proven to be a wonderful way for our school community to interact with our parish communities. If anything is needed for this monthly event, a member of the H & S Council will reach out to you.
- Two Hour Late Start: Please remember that there is a scheduled late start on Tuesday, October 10<sup>th</sup>, when the school doors will open at 10:15 AM and classes will begin at 10:25. Students enrolled in the morning Kid Zone program may come at their typical time and stay in Kid Zone until the school bell rings at 10:15.
- NO SCHOOL: Classes will not be held October 19<sup>th</sup> and 20<sup>th</sup> due to the Education Minnesota Convention. Classes will also not be held on October 23<sup>rd</sup> as this day is scheduled as a Staff Development Day during which the teachers will be receiving online training.

#### **Knights of Columbus Marathon:**

We are thrilled to once again

participate in the Knights of Columbus
Marathon for Nonpublic Education
that will take place on Friday, October
6th, as our students parade through
downtown Wells on a roundabout route to Half Moon
Park. Feel free to join us as in this parade or cheer on
the kids as they pass by!

As a reminder, here are a few key points to this event:

- Marathon Waiver: Please remember to complete your child's waiver and return this form to school prior to October 6<sup>th</sup>.
- Donations: Now's the time for the kids to get busy on this fundraising project by visiting with family and friends to request their financial support in which 100% of the funds go towards the school, its programs and its students. Our goal this year is to raise \$10,000.00 which can be accomplished if every student meets last year's student average collection of \$370.00. Meeting this goal also earns them the right to Silly String Mr. Hengel!
- Marathon Day: Students will assemble in the front of the school at 12:15 PM and marathon in Half Moon Park until 2:00 PM when they will return to school for the Knights of Columbus Prize Program.
- H & S and SCS Prize Programs: We have some fun prizes available as listed in the marathon packet, and in order to make sure to qualify for the prize program, please remember to turn in the collection form and total donations to school by noon on October 26<sup>th</sup>. Please note that the prize program event has been changed to October 27<sup>th</sup> beginning at 1:45 PM.

#### What is gift card fundraising?

#### How do you earn money for St. Casimir's School?

For every gift card purchased, you receive earnings up to 20%. The earnings come from the gift card brand you are purchasing—their way of supporting organizations and communities like yours.

6% average earnings (much more than the average credit card rewards program!)

#### How do you earn money for your student's tuition?

The earnings you receive are split; 50% to the school and 50% towards chosen student(s).

Example: Buy a \$50 Buffalo Wild Wings card at 8% earnings. So, \$2 goes toward student tuition and \$2 towards St Casimir's School.

Go to raiseright.com or download the app. Use the enrollment code for St. Casimir's School: EL9F81B84L764

There will be a question: Who are you fundraising for? Enter student(s) name. Get your family and friends to sign up too and enter students name to earn money faster!

The next disbursement will be December/January.

Don't want to buy online? Physical gift cards are available for purchase at church office 8am-2pm M-F or at the Home and School Second Sunday Social which occurs on the second Sunday of each month of school.
