Hello from Kindergarten! We have been very busy learning new sight words in Reading and Language Arts. So far we have been introduced to 18 sight words since the beginning of the school year. We have also been working on decodable words, which are words that can be sounded out. We have been learning the difference between fiction and nonfiction stories in our reading series while also learning about realistic fiction. In Math, we are currently revisiting the math that was not completed in Preschool. The kids are calling this "easy math"! Once we have completed this math we will go back to doing first grade level math. We are doing this to help prepare our students for the new curriculum from the diocese. This curriculum is more rigorous than the current curriculum; that is why we are using first grade math in Kindergarten. We are currently working on telling time by the hour on analog and digital clocks. We are coming to the end of our Social Studies unit. We should be having our test in this subject by next Tuesday.
